# ÉCOLE CHARLIE KILLAM HOCKEY ACADEMY

## **What is the ÉCKS Hockey Academy?**

École Charlie Killam School Hockey Academy is a partnership between Tim Green Hockey Development and HSC & Hockey Skills where student athletes can focus on both academic achievement and individual skill development.

## **Hockey Staff**

Mr. Tim Green, Mr. Pat Findlay and Mr. Shawn Novokowski are lead instructors within our program. In addition to this instruction we also have weekly goalie-specific instruction and guest coaches throughout the 4 month term.

## **Eligibility**

ÉCKS Hockey Academy is designed for students, male or female, in grades 6-8, who are registered at Charlie Killam School. We are looking for someone who is disciplined, committed and dedicated to academics as well as his/her hockey. It is recommended but not required that participants have a minimum of 1 year experience in minor hockey.

## **Selection Criteria**

Students will be selected on a variety of criteria. Commitment to academics, dedication to hockey, coachability and potential for growth are all areas to be considered. The evaluation of the completed application form will be used to determine acceptance into the program. A personal interview may be required.

### **Academic Expectations**

ÉCKS Hockey Academy participants are student-athletes and academics must be a priority. Although Hockey Academy is the vehicle for Physical Education during the first semester, there are extra opportunities and privileges for students in the program so, ideally students are expected to maintain passing grades in each of the 4 core subjects and contribute positively within their classes and activities in the school day. Failing to maintain the above mentioned may result in a referral to the school's administration who will review each case on its own merits and may implement measures until marks and or behaviors return to an acceptable level.

### **General Behavior**

Respect for others, a strong work ethic, coachability, cooperativeness, and accountability are all attributes our hockey academy expects from the participants. Students of our academy are expected to conduct themselves appropriately on and off the ice as stated in the [ECKS Cougar Code](#) and the [BRSD Code of Conduct](#). A student may be removed from the program due to behavior problems whether problems occur at school or at the rink.

### **Dates and Times**

TBA - 3 on-ice sessions and 2 off-ice sessions per full week of school.

### **Financial Costs**

The cost will be approximately \$150 per month paid to École Charlie Killam School. The total program cost of \$750 covers ice-rental for the on-ice sessions, staffing for both on and off-ice training, dry-land t-shirts/shorts, jerseys and socks. Parents may wish to purchase extra insurance through various insurance programs. Extra nominal costs may occur throughout the year.

There are no refunds for students leaving the program part way through a month or for students missing ice time.

School Fees are paid to École Charlie Killam School.

## **General Program Information**

Students will participate in three 55 minute on-ice sessions and two 42 minute off-ice sessions during each full week from the start of the school year until January 30. These sessions take the place of Physical Education classes only.

### **On-ice sessions**

- The on-ice sessions are all skills based sessions teaching new skills and perfecting learned skills.
- They will be strictly supplementary to the existing programs run by Camrose Minor Hockey.
- This program is not designed to establish or develop teams for competition.

### **Off-ice sessions**

### **Transportation**

Parents are responsible for getting their own child to the Camrose Encana Center for the on-ice sessions that start at 7:45 am. It is important to arrive early enough to be ready to begin practice on time, so students are encouraged to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the session. All students have the opportunity to come on the ice 15 minutes before practice to work on their skills. The City of Camrose has provided us with an area within the Border Rink so that students can store their equipment and parents can pick it up at their convenience later that day. There will be bussing available to transport students back to the school for period 2.

## **Application Information**

**We ask all participants to complete and submit our ÉCKS HOCKEY ACADEMY GOOGLE FORM by June 10, 2022**

**Hockey Academy has been designed to have a minimum of 24 students to a maximum of 55 students. If in the event registration exceeds the maximum, acceptance will be based on student application form and the time the form was submitted.**
